



Hannah at 3 months



Olivia a few weeks after birth

As a 9-1-1 dispatcher, it is my duty to provide support to people at a time when they need it most. In 2007, when I had an emergency C-Section and gave birth to twin girls who were only 24 weeks along, I would need someone else to provide that same **SUPPORT** to me. **I FOUND THAT IN THE RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE**.

At birth, Hannah weighed one pound nine ounces and Olivia weighed 12 ounces. Hannah developed an intestinal disease and was airlifted to St. John's Children's Hospital in Springfield. I was in such shock that I didn't even process where we were going to stay. That's when we learned about the Ronald McDonald House. **THE HOUSE GAVE US A SENSE OF NORMALCY** at a time that was very stressful. Since I didn't have to worry about whether or not I had to pay a hotel bill or what I was going to eat, I could focus all my energy on my twin girls.

WE STAYED AT THE RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE FOR ALMOST A TOTAL OF FOUR MONTHS through all of Hannah's surgeries. When Olivia soon developed the same condition as Hannah and was also airlifted to St. John's, I felt as if we already had a family at the House. Olivia's condition worsened quickly, and we lost her on December 14, 2007. The volunteers and staff at the House were so comforting at such a dark time in my life.

I CAN HONESTLY SAY THAT I HAVE NO IDEA WHAT I WOULD HAVE DONE WITHOUT THE RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE. Ever since our stay, I try to sponsor a night once a year for a family in memory of Olivia. You may never have to use the Ronald McDonald House, BUT I GUARANTEE THAT IT MEANS THE WORLD TO SOMEONE WHO DOES.
